General Information

Cairo Lodge is the Claresholm chapter of the Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, instated on June 24, 1908. This is a male only club, set up as a fraternal lodge. - 3. Acceptance into a post-secondary institution (preference will be given to those accepted to a Canadian College or University)

- 1. A cover letter outlining the above criteria
- 2. Two letters of reference (1 academic, 1 non-academic)
- 3. A copy of conditional acceptance to a post-secondary institution

Applications are to be emailed to Brad Toone (<u>tooneb@lrsd.ab.ca</u>) by May 31st of each year in order to be considered for this award. The winner of the award will be announced at graduation. A cheque will be made jointly out to the student and the school.
